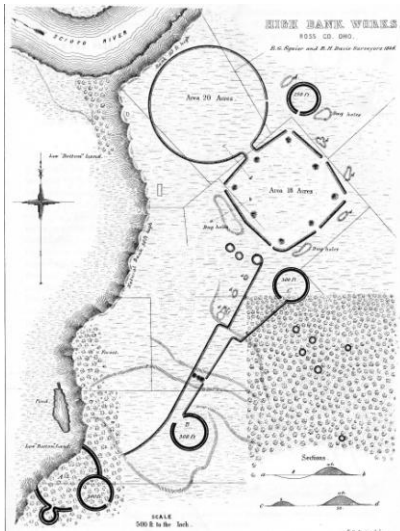
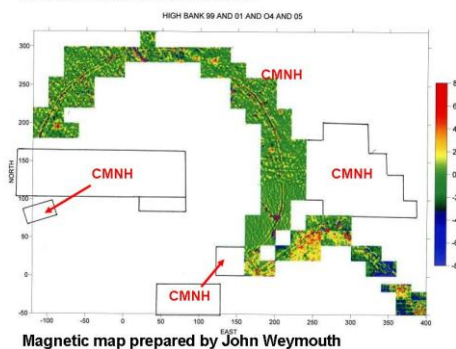


Donald S. Dean 2010 Adopt-a-Student Internship Archaeology at High Bank Earthworks



An opportunity is available to participate in field work at High Bank Earthworks, Ross County, Ohio that will seek to find the source of significant geophysical anomalies recorded in 2007. This work is a continuation of Cleveland Museum of Natural History studies of this Hopewellian geometric enclosure. All walls of the complex ground plan have been eroded by modern land use. Geophysical surveys have successfully mapped parts of the enclosure. This aids in comparing the site with Newark Earthworks, the only other known Hopewell enclosure that includes an octagon.
